- 1. Participants in activities at Dream Catcher Farm must follow verbal instructions from owner/members of the farm.**
- 2. Participants at Dream Catcher Farm must sign a release of liability before handling or riding any of the horses.**
- 3. Participants are not to approach or handle horses that they do not know. Participants should only handle their designated horses under the conditions of their lesson or lease.**
- 4. Be respectful and considerate of other users of the property, round pen, arena, tack room, tie areas, bridle paths, and other general use areas.**
- 5. Riders under 18 years of age must wear an approved riding helmet whenever mounted. An approved riding helmet is required for riders of all ages while jumping. Riders of all ages are recommended to wear an approved riding helmet.**
- 6. Required apparel is as follows: individuals must wear closed toe shoes when handling and riding horses. Boots with a heel and full-length pants are highly recommended.**
- 7. Horses should be tied to the provided hitching post, cross ties, or horse trailer when grooming or tacking up. Horses may not be tied to any other spots.**
- 8. Tack and supplies should be returned to their designated locations after use in the condition they were found in.**
- 9. Rider is responsible for cleaning hair and manure messes up after the horse they are handling. Muck buckets and scoopers are provided.**
- 10. Rider needs to give notice before coming to Dream Catcher Farm unless a prior arrangement or appointment exists.**
- 11. The designated parking area is located on the gravel pad near the horse trailer just before the orange storage unit. Additional parking is available in front of the second house.**
- 12. Smoking is not permitted in either of the houses, the tack shed, barns, hay shed, or general horse areas.**
- 13. No outside pets are permitted at Dream Catcher Farm without prior arrangements.**
- 14. Participants under 18 years of age are not permitted to handle the stallion at Dream Catcher Farm.**
